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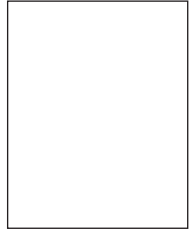

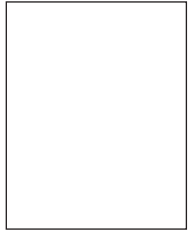

FOREWORD

Mar Gregorious Memorial (M.G.M) Higher Secondary School, Dimapur was founded in the year 1985. M. G. M. Schools are a chain of educational institutions of the Malankara Orthodox Syrian Church (also referred as Indian Orthodox Church Founded By St. Thomas, the Apostle of Jesus Christ in A.D.52) spreading the light of knowledge throughout India. Everywhere, M. G. M. Schools stand in high esteem with excellent standard and best discipline. The first M.G.M. School was established in Kerala in honour of Mar Gregorious the 19th century Bishop of Syrian Orthodox Church who was a great educationist and social reformer. Mar Gregorious is the first Indian Christian to be proclaimed as a saint. The co-operative efforts of the Orthodox Church members in Nagaland and other well-wishers has brought M.G.M. school Dimapur into existence. Late glorified Arch Bishop Dr. Stephanos Mar Theodosius is the founder of the School. Now we have Nursery to Class XII with Science, Commerce and Arts streams in Higher Secondary classes. It is nothing but Divine Grace and the powerful intercession of the Great Saint that enables us to tread the height of excellence day by day.

VISION

To provide quality education for holistic development of the child through new ways of teaching & learning process in order to mould future global citizens.

AIMS & OBJECTIVES

The objective of the school is not only to impart instruction and instill an inspiration of knowledge but also to develop good character on the basis of fundamental values of life as propounded

by Jesus Christ. It is also our aim to prepare the pupils to fulfill their noble role in life wherever they might be placed.

The School provides all round education in a congenial atmosphere to develop the physical, mental and spiritual potentialities of children. The school imparts religious and moral instructions with due respect to all religions with a view to provide the children right principles of conduct at all times. We invoke the intercession of our great Saint for the realization of our dreams. Special attention is given to ensure a high standard of morality and discipline in the school.

MANAGEMENT

M.G.M. Hr. Sec. School is managed by St. Thomas Mission Society under the Mission Board of Kolkata Diocese of the Orthodox Church of India. Arch Bishop Alexios Mar Eusebius is the President of the School, A Governing body, constituted by the President from among the Dimapur Mar Gregorious Orthodox Syrian church members is catering to the day to day affairs of the School with Priest serving as the Vice President.

ADMISSION & ACADEMICS

1. The School accepts good and earnest students irrespective of caste, creed and tribe. Pupils coming with the transfer certificates from other schools may be admitted to the class for which he/she is found fit and if vacancy is available.
2. All pupils must speak in English in the school premises. This would make them proficient in conversational English. If the pupils use any other language or dialect they are liable to sanctions which include fines.

3. Every student attending the school is obliged to take part in the school singing, drill, social work, games and sports and activities of the school.

FEES

4. Fees must be paid at South Indian Bank, Near Bishop House, Circular Road, Dimapur. Fine of Rs 30/- per month will be charged from fee defaulters.
5. If a student fails to pay the fee for 2 consecutive installments his/ her name will be struck off from the roll, but for special reasons they may be re-admitted on payment of arrears and re-admission fee of Rs. 1500/-
6. Defaulters won't be issued admit card which will debar them from appearing the examination
7. Parents may kindly save the receipts issued to them and produce the same as proof of the payment of fees when needed.

N.B: Fees once paid is not refundable.

ATTENDANCE

Attendance in class is compulsory for all. Students having below 80% of attendance is liable to be debarred from appearing Selection test/Final Exam. If a student is absent for more than 15 consecutive days without prior intimation and approval his/ her name will be struck off from the roll. In cases of special consideration, they may be re-admitted with a re-admission fee of Rs. 1000/-.

CHANGE OF HOME ADDRESS/ PHONE NUMBER

Any Change in home address or Phone number of the student shall be intimated immediately to the office and due direction shall be done in the 'Identity Certificate' page in the school diary with the permission of the Class Teacher..

Medium of instruction:

The medium of instruction and examination for all subjects shall be English except for Hindi.

HOSTEL

MGM school is also running a hostel for its student both boys and girls. Uninterrupted Power Supply, 24 hours water supply, fitness equipments, regular Prayer & meditation are the specialities of MGM Hostel.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Every student is expected to be respectful, polite, punctual, humble, honest and be courteous in speech and conduct towards the teacher, staff and other students inside and outside the school campus. Refined manners, decorum and cleanliness should be the hallmark of the students. MGM Hr. Sec. School, Dimapur is a Tobacco Free School. Consumption of tobacco in any form is an offence and may lead to a fine of Rs. 500/- and suspension or expulsion from the School.

GENERAL RULES OF THE SCHOOL

1. The school hours are from 7:45am up to 1:40p.m (any change will be notified). Every student is expected to be punctual.
2. The use of other language or dialect other than English is strictly prohibited.
3. Any act of indiscipline, disrespect or provoking behavior uncalled for in the school towards any staff members or students will not be tolerated and may lead to expulsion from the school.
4. Expensive ornaments, disproportionate amount other than fees, mobile phones or other possessions not suitable for use in school are prohibited.
5. Make up such as lipstick, nail polish, cosmetics, tattoo or indecent dresses are prohibited. Wearing of ear rings, necklace, bangles etc. for boys are strictly prohibited. Hair should be cut short and properly groomed or combed. Spiky hair style is not permitted.
6. Gadgets like Mobile phones, i-pods, laptops etc. which are not part of school syllabus shall be seized and won't be returned.
7. School diary must be brought to school daily.
8. Participation of students is a must in all the co- curricular activities.
9. It is mandatory to attend morning assembly.
10. Students should be habitually clean and neatly dressed. The school uniform is to be worn on all class days. All the necessary books shall be brought to the school. A student who is slovenly dressed or without proper books may be excluded from the class room or even sent home. The school cannot be held responsible if anything untoward happens when a student is sent home for the above reasons.

11. The school cannot be held responsible for any minor or major accidents to students during the stay in the school or while taking part in sports or other co curricular activities within or outside the school premises.
12. Any kinds of damage to property whether of the school or of its inmates should be made good either individually or collectively.
13. No books, (other than text books or library books). magazines or papers may be brought to school without permission.
14. Parents and guardians should not visit their wards or their teachers in the class room without the Principal's permission. Parents are not allowed to use school toilets without permission.
15. Letters addressed to and received by the children may be delivered open. Letters written in English only will be delivered.
16. No student may leave the school premises during the class hours or recess time without the permission of the school authority. If anyone is found violating the rules, he/she may be suspended and later dismissed.
17. The school reserves the right to penalize, suspend and expel students whose conduct is detrimental to the interest of the school. The following behaviour or activity could lead to fine and / or suspension or expulsion of a student.
 - a) Negligence of classes, weekly -tests, evaluation, homework or other school function.
 - b) Disrespect towards the school authority, teachers and other staff.
 - c) Destroying school property.
 - d) Assault/threat on teachers or other staff & fellow students inside & outside of the school.

- e) Using unfair means in examination.
 - f) Irregularity in attendance or regular late coming.
 - g) Truancy
 - h) The use of intoxicating drink, smoking, chewing of tobacco / pan / betel nut or any kind of drugs.
18. Parents/Guardian are not allowed to enter the classroom or staff room without permission.

LEAVE

1. A student who has been absent from class must state the reason for absence in the 'leave/absence record' page in the diary signed by the parent with the date. Failing to do so a student will have to pay a fine of Rs. 20 per day.
2. A student who comes 3 days late in a month will be sent back home and parents will be called for an explanation.
3. Absence without leave application after any vacation renders the student a fine of Rs. 100 on re-opening day and Rs. 20 on subsequent days.
4. A student who is absent for more than 3 consecutive days due to sickness should produce medical certificate. In case of non availability of the same the parent has to personally clarify, otherwise, the student will not be allowed to sit in the class.
5. No leave of absence will be sanctioned nor a pupil be without a prior written application for leave from his/her parent. Excuses as birthdays, excursions, festivals, urgent business, preparation for examination etc. are not considered as sufficient reasons.
6. Leave for religious ceremonies or special occasions must be obtained in advance.'

EXAMINATION & PROMOTION

1. Apart from the Final examination there will be class test, Unit test and Terminal Quarterly Examinations during the year and the Report Card will keep the parents informed of the progress of their child. The reports are to be duly signed by the parents and returned to school. ‘
2. Students absent from the examination shall be considered failed.
3. There will be continuous assessment of pupil’s work throughout the year. Promotion will depend on the year’s work and the final decision depends entirely on the Principals discretion.
4. A pupil who fails twice in the same class will be asked to leave the school.
5. The results declared at the end of the year are final and will not be reconsidered.

DETAINING OF CANDIDATES

The school reserves the right to detain candidates from appearing the Final/Board examination on account of any of the following reasons:

1. If there is no sign of academic improvement in the weekly, monthly tests and terminal examination.
2. Gross misconduct and insubordination to the school authority.
3. Failure to attend Special classes.
4. Non-payments of fees (school fees, examination fees. etc)
5. Fail to abide by the rules of the school
6. Students whose attendance is less than 80%
7. Any other reason for which the school deems necessary to take action.

WITHDRAWAL OF STUDENTS

- (a) At least 5 days notice in writing on a prescribed form is to be given duly signed by the guardian/parent before withdrawing a student from the school
- (b) T.C. is ordinarily issued within seven days of application on clearance of all dues.
- (c) Student who is detained in the same class for two years in succession will not be retained in the school.
- (d) The school reserves the right to insist the parents to withdraw their children if their progress in studies is unsatisfactory or their attendance is irregular or their conduct is harmful to other children.
- (e) After taking admission, if a student leave the school before completion of the session, the student has to pay whole year fees.

RECOMMENDATION TO PARENTS

1. Parents should carefully study the regulations about absence from the school and payment of fees and observe them faithfully.
2. Parents are earnestly requested to enforce regularity and discipline at home and see to it that their children prepare lessons and-do the assigned home work.
3. Parents are allowed to meet the teachers only after 1.40 p.m for Class 1 to 12 and after 12 noon for Pre-primary. No parent is allowed to visit the class room to meet teacher or student during school hours.
4. Private tuitions are not encouraged in the school campus.

5. Criticism of a child's teachers or school should be , totally avoided, because the student will lose all respect for his/her teacher, also it will affect the students negatively.
6. Withdrawal of your child from classes for social functions is not recommended, because it retards the child's progress in school and minimizes his/her respect for regularity and hard work, with consequent failure to progress in his/her studies.
7. Any communication, request or complaint made by . parents/guardians should be addressed to the Principal. These communications are most welcome.
8. Ordinary communication to parents and guardians will be made through the school calendar. They are kindly requested to read and sign it.
9. Students are responsible for the custody of their books and other belongings.
10. School will follow the holidays and class days as given in the school calender. If there is any change due to unforeseen circumstances, it will always be communicated accordingly.

WHAT IS EXPECTED FROM OUR STUDENTS

1. The Gregorians (students of Mar Gregorious Memorial Hr. Sec. School) should take good care of their health and keep themselves robust and strong
2. They should always be friendly with others in and out of the school.
3. They should avoid vulgarity in talk and behavior.

4. They should accept whatever work assigned to them as their rightful share. They should face difficulties courageously.
5. They should always be ready to lend a helping hand at home to their parents, brothers and sisters and in school to teachers and companions and any unattended visitor they happen to meet in the school premises.
