Admission Procedure

- 1. Obtain Prospectus & Application Form from the Office by paying the required fees.

MGM Hr. Sec. School, Dimapur was founded by Late Lamented Arch Bishop Dr. Stephanos Mar Theodosius in 1985. At present the school has Nursery to Class XII with Science, Arts and Commerce streams for Higher Secondary.

Aims & Objectives

Management

MGM Hr. Sec. School is managed by St. Thomas Mission Society, Dimapur under the Mission Board of Kolkata Diocese of the Malankara Orthodox Syrian Church. Arch Bishop Alexious Mar Easebius, Metropolitan of Calcutta Diocese is the president of the School. A Governing body constituted by the President from among



Documents to be submitted at the time of Admission:

- 6. Permanent Education Number (PEN) Admission will be canceled if PEN is not available.

General Rules of the School

- 1. The school hours are from 7.45 am up to 1.50 pm. Each student is expected to be in school in time and leave the school on time.
- 2. The use of other language or dialect other than English is strictly prohibited.
- No act of indiscipline, disrespect or provocative behavior in the school towards any staff members or students will not be tolerated and may lead to expulsion form the school.
- 4. Make up such as lipstick, nail polish, cosmetics, tattoo or indecent dresses for girls are prohibited.
- 5. Putting ear rings, necklace, bangles, tattoo etc. for boys are strictly prohibited. Hair should be cut short and properly groomed or combed. Spiky hair style is not permitted. Students with Tattoo on visible part of the body will not be given Admission. Tattoos made after admission or during the course period will result in the expulsion of the student.
- 6. Students should come in proper uniform. T-shirt, Shirts must be tucked in properly; Pants, skirts must be worn at the waist and skirts should be knee length. Shoes should be plain, simple and laced.
- 7. Gadgets like Mobile phones, i-pods, etc. which are not a part of school syllabus shall be seized and won't be returned.





- 8. School calendar/diary must be brought to school daily.
- 9. It is mandatory to attend morning assembly and co-curricular activities.

The school reserves the right to penalize, suspend and expel students whose conduct is detrimental to the interest of the school. The following behavior or activity could lead to heavy fine / suspension or both or expulsion of a student:

- a) Use of intoxicating drink, smoking, chewing of tobacco / pan / supari or any kinds of drugs.
- b) Irregularity, absenteeism, and absent in the class during weekly tests, examinations.
- c) Disrespect towards the school authority, teachers or other staff.
- d) Destruction of school property
- e) Bullying, Ragging or any kind of aggressive behaviors towards other students.
- f) Assault / Threat on teachers or other staff.
- g) Using unfair means in examination.
- h) Truancy.

Fee

Fees must be paid within the date mentioned in the fee book If fees paid after the stipulated date, Rs. 30 late fine will be charged. In case, a student fails to pay the fees for 2 consecutive installments, his/her name will be struck off from the roll, but for genuine reasons student shall be readmitted on payment of arrears and Readmission fees of Rs. 1000/-

NB: Fees once paid is not refundable.

Attendance and Leave of Absence

Attendance in class is compulsory for all. Students having below 85% of attendance are liable to be debarred from appearing Selection Test / Final Exam.

- A Student who has been absent from class must state reason for absence in the 'leave/absence record' page in the diary signed by the parent. Failing student will have to pay a fine of Rs. 50 per day.
- 2. A student who comes late for 3 days in a month, he/ she will be sent back home and parent will be called for explanation.

- 3. Absence without leave application, after any vacation renders the student a fine of Rs. 100/- on re-opening day and Rs. 50 per day on subsequent days.
- 4. A student who is absent for more than 3 consecutive days due to sickness shall produce medical certificate. In case of non availability of the same the parent has to personally report to the class teacher, otherwise the student will not be allowed to sit in the class.
- 5. If a student is absent for more than 7 consecutive days his/her name will be struck off from the roll. The right to give or deny re-admission to such students will be the discretion of Principal. Re-admission fee will be charged.

MGM School is also running a hostel for its students for both boys and girls.

Detention

The school reserves the right to detain candidates from appearing the Board Examination on account of any one of the following reason:

- 1. If there is no sign of academic improvement in the weekly/monthly tests and terminal examination.
- 2. Gross misconduct and insubordination to the school authority.
- 3. Failure to attend coaching classes.
- 4. Non-payments of fees (school fees, examination fees, etc.)
- 5. Failure to abide by the rules of the school.
- 6. Any other reason which the school deemed necessary to take action.
- 7. Students whose attendance is less than 80%.
